The Topical Fluoride Program for students in Farmington is in full swing in the district according to a report given to the Farmington Board of Education on September 27.

Sponsored by the Farmington Area Council of PTAs, applications of fluoride were received by 2,487 children in grades K, 2, 5 and 8, (including Our Lady of Sorrows School) last year. This was a 55 per cent participation of all children enrolled in these grades.

Because of the continued increase in participation each year, the committee plans to schedule two hygienists during the month of May, 1966. A schedule, September through May, has been set up and is now in operation. The fee of \$3.00 will remain the same for this year.

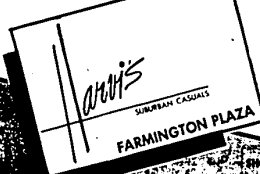

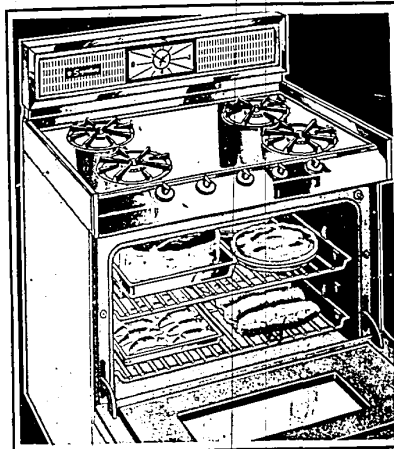

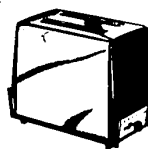
