

Top Ranked Grid Power Toppled At Falcon Homecoming, 21 to 7

Wow—whewee!! Farmington came through with the major upset of the year Friday evening, fifth-ranked East Detroit 21-7. The Falcons exploded for three touchdowns in the first half, then added a two-point safety with 26 seconds remaining to close out the high-flying Shamrocks.

"It was a team victory," stated Richard Tyler, head coach of the Falcons. "There was more hard hitting and hustle than we have had in all the other games this year. The boys played the kind of ball they are capable of playing. There were very few mistakes—and NO fumbles," explained Tyler. "The front of the line had the best game they have ever had the last two or three years."

Leading the way for Farmington were three individual performances by Wayne Johnson, Mike Wilson, and Mike Perry.

Fullback Johnson averaged exactly four yards a carry as he piled up 92 yards rushing, and scored the first Farmington touchdown of the game. Mike Wilson, Falcon quarterback, threw for two touchdowns passes in the game. The first

went 32 yards into the arms of senior end Dan Klawender; the other to Gerry Tinkle for six more points, and a 19 point lead built in.

Defensively, linebacker Mike Perry seemed to be guided to the right spots at the right time. He recovered a fumble on the East Detroit 32 to set up the Falcons' second score, and snatched a pass in the last quarter to smother the last Shamrock scoring attack.

Farmington held East Detroit to 85 yards total in the first half. In the last half, the Shamrocks managed to push across one touchdown, on a 14

yard run by Mike Frabott. Frabott, who carried 14 times for 70 yards, was the leading ground gainer for the losing East Detroit team.

East Detroit went into the October 11 game with a 4-0 record—they had shut-out every previous opponent this year, while they had amassed 95 points for a 24 point average.

The Falcon 11 will try to improve upon their current 3-2 record tomorrow when they do battle with the Walled Lake football squad. Walled Lake, the perennial powerhouse of the Inter-Lakes Conference, has won three games this season—two of them conference victories.

The game, which starts at 8:00 p.m. Friday at Walled Lake High, is Farmington's third conference game of the season.

"We expect it to be a rough game," said Tyler, "but if we play as well as we did against East Detroit, they can be beaten."

Rocket Varsity Downs T-Birds

Although the Farmington Junior Football Rocket Varsity was victorious there were many tense moments before the end of the game last Saturday. It was a joyous victory for Coach Renee who now has beaten two of the Dearborn teams and tied one. The Rockets downed their Dearborn T-Bird opponents Saturday, 18 to 13.

THE ROCKETS' FIRST touchdown came after the ball control by the Rockets with continued gains by Steinko, Gow and Herpich, with Rick Herpich scoring on a reverse covering the last 25 yards. The extra point was missed and the score was 6 to 0.

The second Farmington touchdown was set up as a result of a beautiful pass from Drew Mahalic to Craig Dhue which covered almost 40 yards. It was here that the hard running backs of the Rockets took over and Mike Gow ploughed over for TD. Again the extra point was missed. Score 12 to 0.

The T-Birds then took to the air and scored on a 12 yard pass before the end of the half. Half time score 12 to 6.

It was the result of a recovered fumble that led to the third TD which was scored by Rick Herpich. The extra point was missed and the score became 18 to 6. Soon after the kickoff the T-Birds passed again for a score and made the extra point making the final score 18 to 13.

Although the Rocket defense tried to stop the T-Birds they just could not contain the hard running Dearborn backs. The final score was T-Birds 20—Farmington 6.

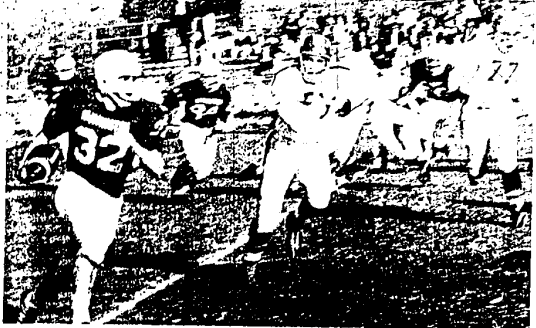

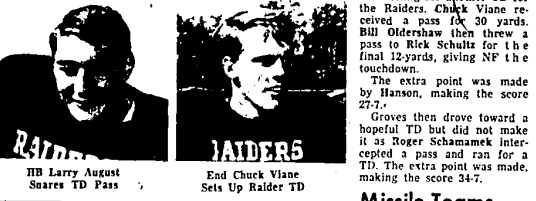
