Clarenceville Methodist Church To Consecrate New Building Unit

Clarenceville Methodist Church, located on Grand River Ave. and Collingham in Farmington, since 1920, will move to their new location on Middlebelt Road, Livonia, Mich. very soon, it was announced this week.

Consecration Services for the new Educational Unit, first of four buildings to be built, will be Sunday, November 14, at 3 p.m. An Open House, with refreshments, will follow the Consecration Service.

Dr. Merle D. Broyles, Detroit District Superintendent, will lead in the service and be assisted by the Reverend Herbert F. Hauser, Executive Secretary of the Methodist Union, Dr. Benjamin F. Holme, formerly Executive Secretary of the Methodist Union and now retired, and Dr. Jesse DeWitt, Executive Secretary of the Conference Board of Missions.

THE REVEREND Elsie A. Johns has been a Pastor of the Church since 1941. The Church at that time did not have any membership and has grown to a membership of well over one thousand.

The new site is an eight acre site and will afford plenty of parking. The new building contains ample classroom facilities, nurseries, office space, a church library, kitchen, and a fellowship hall, which will be used as a temporary worship center. In the future, a sanctuary, chapel and gymnasium will be added.

The Architects are Begrow and Brown, Birmingham, Michigan, and the General Contractor is The James Moriarty Company. Mr. Clifton Miracle is chairman of the building committee.

North Church To Present Guest Speaker
The Reverend A. Vaughan Abernethy, Executive Secretary of the National Association of Congregational Christian Churches, will preach at North Congregational Church, Northwestern Highway at Lahser, Sunday morning. His sermon will be titled, "The Faith of Our Beloved Fathers".

Rev. Abernethy was ordained in 1950 at the Riverpoint Church, West Warwick, Rhode Island, and served the Riverpoint Church until 1956 when he was called to be minister of the First Congregational Church of Tacoma, Washington, where he still resides.

A graduate of Marietta College in Ohio, Rev. Abernethy took his post-graduate work in theological education as a member of the class of 1943 at Harvard Divinity School.

The minister said he also would discuss "the usefulness as well as the dangers and historical origins of 'romantic love.'"

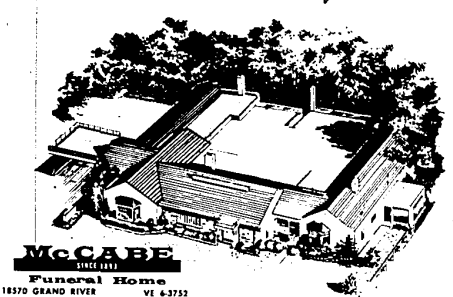
