The Woman's Society of Christian Service at First Methodist Church focus their attention on "Operation Headstart to Fewer Dropouts" for the general meeting Tuesday, January 25. An informative program on this one area of community interest will be presented by two public school staff members, Mrs. Marjorie Elcher, Community Relations Coordinator of the Farmington Public School System, and Virginia Carley, Counselor at Farmington Senior High.

Mrs. Elcher will describe "Operation Headstart" as it now functions in Farmington.
