

Issue Request for Hygienists

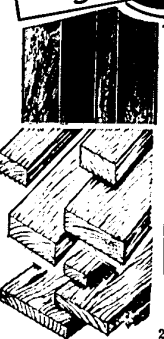

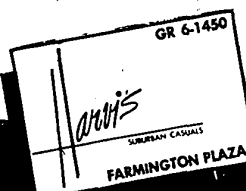
