Films, filmstrips, records, and other audio-visual materials have been used by the teachers and the music consultant in motivating the youngsters for this event.

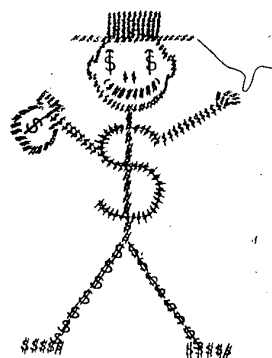
