

Comedy Slated To Open Feb. 5 at Redford Union

Witches, seances and Ouija boards are ingredients of a delightful comedy now in rehearsal by the Bulman Theatre Group of Redford Township. The play, "All Because of Agatha," will be presented for the entertainment of area families on Saturday and Sunday, Feb. 5 and 6.

The fanciful play features an attractive witch—strikingly portrayed by Mary Pruss, 16620 Lola Drive, and her annual visit to haunt a Salem, Mass. house.

Her efforts to follow a pledge made 250 years earlier—before being burned at the stake—and drive the current occupants

from the house provide many humorous situations and laughs for the entire family.

Residents of the haunted house are Duff O'Hara, a car-leader, played by George Carlton, 15513 Lexington; and his wife, Joan, Shirley Atkinson, 26437 St. Paul, who plays Joan's real-life husband, Don, has the role of a brash reporter who senses a scoop in the annual visit of the witch.
