**'Preach the Gospel'**  
*Urges Plymouth Minister*

Rev. Donald Williams, minister of Plymouth's First Baptist Church is considered one of Plymouth's outstanding ministers. In conversation with him, it is not difficult to discover why. He is a man who calls a spade a spade and is able to see all sides of a problem clearly, even though he may have strong opinions about it.

The Observer decided to interview him and ask him about the problems he would face during his term as president of the Plymouth Ministerial Association. Instead, Rev. Williams spoke about what he considers the foremost problem of the clergy today, namely, lack of knowledge of the gospel.

Rev. Williams believes that not only the laymen, but an amazingly large number of the clergy are not well informed about the Bible.

"This was surprising to us and we asked him the obvious question, 'Isn't the study of the Bible the most important course in the education of a minister?'"

"No," said Rev. Williams, "there are studies in humanly, philosophy, etc." He added that he had a doctor's degree in psychology. He feels that while
