Fire fighters sustain injuries at a rate seven times the industrial workman.

The truth is the majority of fires like babies, are born in the pre-dawn hours. These fires are more dangerous, because not only is there the hazard of the fire, but usually the electricity is out and with smoke and darkness it is hard to see the danger of a falling wall or brick. Hardly a fire of this type ever occurs without injury, or, in many cases, death.

Aside from the night run fires, even the most mill-ant government administrator can't take away the fact that the fire fighter is away from his family 56 hours a week, which is 16 hours more a week than his counterpart in the police department. This can make a lot of difference in a wife and kids—and puts them in a different category on the block than the families of any other workers.
