Christian Scientists Observe Centennial

Plans for a year-long observance of the 100th anniversary of Christian Science have been announced by the Christian Science Board of Directors of The Mother Church, the First Church of Christ, Scientist, in Boston, Mass.

Major events will include a world-wide public speaking tour by the Editor in Chief of the Christian Science Monitor, publication of a new book titled "A Century of Christian Science Healing," and the start of work on a new "Church Center" construction program.

The Centennial stems from events in 1866 which marked the turning point in the life of Mary Baker Eddy and began her pioneering of a world religious movement.

In the winter of 1866, a young widow named Mary Baker Eddy was seriously injured in a fall on a icy sidewalk in Lynn, Mass. She made a sudden and complex recovery, after a close brush with death.

These circumstances caused her to become the director and

founder of the Christian Science Church.

Her Christian Science textbook which she wrote called, "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures," became the textbook for the church which now includes 5,800 branches in more than 50 countries.

Mrs. Eddy became convinced that the Principle underlying the life and teaching of Jesus is fundamental to existence itself—"The divine Principle of all real being." This became the basic premise of Christian Science.

Spiritual healing is considered to be one of the natural outgrowths when the individual begins to commit himself to working out his life from the standpoint of this premise.

The individual Christian Scientist normally feels a deep necessity to bring the practice of his religion increasingly into every aspect of his life. It must transform his own motives and acts, the way he conducts his business or profession, his family and community responsibilities.
