

Wonderland to Present Setter in Sale

Aragon's "Captain Scarlet," a six-week-old pedigree Irish Setter, will be awarded Saturday as the climax of Wonderland Center's three-day "Luck O' the Irish" sale.

The pup, sired by one of the nation's outstanding setters, will go to the person whose name is chosen at a drawing to be held at 8 p.m. in the Wonderland Mall.

"Captain Scarlet," bred by Farmington's Aragon Kennels, is the descendant of a two-time national show champion. He will be six weeks old Friday.

Registrations for the dog will be accepted until 7:45 p.m. Saturday, March 19, according to Ernie Epps, Wonderland promotion director. The contest is open to all age groups, but only one entry can be accepted from each individual.

"Captain Scarlet," will be on display in the Wonderland Mall this Friday and Saturday. An official entry blank appears in today's edition of The Observer. Additional entry forms are available at most Wonderland stores.

In addition, the winner will receive six cases of Lang's dog food, courtesy of Lang's Feed Supply, 17018 Inkster Road, Romulus.

Hotel Man Again Denied Permit to Build 3rd Story

Burl Woodward, manager of the Hines Park Motel reappeared before the Zoning Board of Appeals last Thursday night to again appeal for a waiver use to build a third story (under 25 feet) on his motel on Plymouth Road.

He was again denied the petition for waiver use "without prejudice" by a 3 to 3 vote.

When asked by the Chairman of the Zoning Board, Robert Nash, why he had not petitioned the Council for this Woodward replied, "I wish I could name names, but I have been told by two Councilmen that the Zoning Board is the place to come for

this request. I cannot discuss the past publicity."

At this point Woodward was interrupted by Nash who said, "Let's not get into that."

Woodward continued and stated he had called the City Attorney and was told that in his opinion it was a Zoning Board matter and was definitely not illegal for the Zoning Board to decide on the case.

The publicity referred to involved a statement Woodward had made to his employer, the owner of the motel, that he was asked for \$3,000 in order to get his case approved by the Zoning Board of Appeals.

The alleged bribery is presently being investigated by Judge Edward Piggins one-man Grand Jury. It probably will not come to any conclusion until after the election.

Mayor Harvey Moelke turned the matter over to the attorney for the Grand Jury investigation.

When questioned Woodward said he would take his case before the Planning Commission or the Council but intended to talk to City Planner Don Hull first.
