The film story of the great Brazilian experiment of moving its capital city into the vastness of unexplored jungle will be told graphically Sunday in the Franklin High auditorium, when the Central Kiwanis Club of Livonia presents world traveler Romain Wilhelmsen and his film "South American Adventure." The showing is slated to start at 7:30 p.m.

Wilhelmsen, a graduate of Jackson High, is a member of the Los Angeles Adventurer's Club and has appeared before more than 2,000 audiences with his six educational movies. He started his film-lecture career in 1953.

"South American Adventure" is the sixth and final of the series sponsored by the Kiwanians. It is the story of an adventurous trip through little known regions of South America and is climaxed by the scene in Brasilia, the new Brazil capital city, which is ranked as the most modern city in the world. Yet it stands alone in the vastness of unexplored jungles.

The story begins in Colombia, tells of Lima, Peru, moves by plane over the Andes at 25,000 feet to the East and into the great Amazon Basin to the jungle city of Iquitos.
