Doctor Urges New Pupils To Get Exams

Children who are entering kindergarten this fall and

Children who are entering kindergarten this fall and who have not had a preschool physical examination should see their doctor some time in July or August to avoid the last minute rush in September.

Luther R. Leader, M.D., Detroit, President of the Michigan State Medical Society, urges that "each child should have a physical examination before entering school or kindergarten. To insure the best of service to the children, doctors recommend that appointments for the examinations be made as early as possible."

Michigan physicians have the cards which the doctor will fill out after the examination. The card is to be presented when the child is registered for school this fall.

Michigan I aw (section 376)
states that all children entering school for the first time
shall submit as tatement
signed by a physician that
they have been immunized
against smallpox, diphtheria,
tuberculosis, tetanus, pertussis and poliomyelitis; a statement signed by one parent or
cuardian to the effect that
the child has not been immunized be cause of religious
convictions or other objection
to immunization; or a request
signed by one parent or
cuardian that the local health
department gives the needed

guardian that the local health department gives the needed protective injections.

Tarents should take their children now for the physical examination to make the process of registration in the fall as efficient and convenient for them as possible, points out Doctor Leader.
