# It's Better With Butter

When the days are hot, the urge to cook wanes. The housewife feels a great need to do as little as possible in the kitchen and yet the generally feels a certain obligation to feed her family food that is appetizing. Well, here it is not.

You do it with butters. In the cool of the morning you can stir a butter into a soft stick of butter at a refrigerator or freeze it all it is needed.

The varieties are many, and your imagination can be put into play, but the major divisions are three: 1) Herb butters, which may be used on cooked vegetables of all kinds, and on baked or broiled meats and fish; 2) Sweet butters, for hot rolls, pancakes, muffins, french toast, and coffee cakes; 3) Cheese butters, pungent additions to hamburgers, hot sandwiches, and steaks, especially when you cooking on your charcoal grill. Cheese butters on crackers are tasty appetizers, too.

- SWEET BUTTERS:**
- To 1 stick of butter add and blend till fluffy: 1/4 cup brown sugar, 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon, 1/4 cup orange juice (or 2 tablespoons frozen orange juice concentrate, undiluted).
  - Or 3 tablespoons light cream, 1 teaspoon sugar, 1 teaspoon vanilla.
  - Or 2 tablespoons lemon juice (or 2 tablespoons frozen orange juice concentrate, undiluted).
- CHEESE BUTTERS:**
- To 1 stick of butter add and blend thoroughly: 3/4 ounce bleu cheese, 1/2 garlic clove (crushed), 1/2 teaspoon salt, 2 tablespoons prepared mustard.
  - Or 1/4 cup grated parmesan, 1/2 cup grated romano, 1/4 cup chianti wine, 1/4 teaspoon salt, and a quick dash each of onion powder, celery salt, oregano, basil, thyme.
  - Or 1 1/2 ounces Roquefort cheese, 1/2 cup white wine, 1/2 teaspoon salt, and a dash each of garlic salt, onion powder, celery salt, paprika, and majoram.
  - Or 3 tablespoons dry vermouth, 1/4 cup grated parmesan, and 1 tablespoon minced fresh parsley.
- All these butters need to be chilled to blend flavors and then softened before use. Getting the liquid ingredients to blend with the butter takes a little perseverance, but it does work.
