Degrees for 2 Residents

U.S. Secretary of Labor W. Willard Wirtz, speaking at Northwestern University's 108th annual commencement, rejected the idea that knowledge — which is "currently breaking through an ignorance barrier" — is civilization's "fatal mistake."

"It is rather," Wirtz said, "that the danger of mistake lies in the possibility of reliance for too long on the old aphorism that the more things change the more they are the same."

"The life of the law," said the Secretary, "can no longer be found in experience, but depends nearly on logic, the premises drawn from the future instead of from the past... Knowledge relies, as it advances, more and more on faith."

Among the 2,834 graduates receiving degrees, Wirtz named:
 • Linwood Hobbs of 34105 Hunters Row, Farmington, Bachelor of Science, and
 • Richard W. Pierce, 27620 Tedesco, Livonia, Juris Doctor degree.

Secretary Wirtz and nine other distinguished persons were awarded honorary degrees by Northwestern.

Firecrackers Are Illegal in Michigan

A youngster is injured in the shoulder by flying pieces of metal. Another almost loses a leg.

Strange enough, these tragedies are repeated every summer with the illegal transportation and use of firecrackers.

Under Michigan State law anyone charged of selling, possessing, transporting or using firecrackers can be convicted with a misdemeanor and can be sent to the County Jail for a stay of not more than 90 days and fined up to \$100.

Local police officials are pointing these facts out to all residents each year at this time. There is an outbreak in the number of injuries to children from the use of firecrackers. Although prohibited in the State of Michigan, firecrackers are legal in Ohio and the southwestern corner of the state is plagued by violations of the law and injuries.

City Recreation Program Opens Monday

The Farmington Area Recreation Commission's program begins next Monday, June 27. Those who have not already registered may pick up registration forms at any of the eight school sites being used in the program — Beechview, Eagle, Kenbrook, and 10 Mile in the Northern section; and Cloverdale, Flanders, Shawasssee, and William Grace in the Southern section. The forms will be available on opening day and throughout the program which runs to Aug. 8.

Youngsters, who must have attained the age of eight years and may not exceed 15 years of age, are requested to register at the site nearest their homes.

The schedule calls for the north section to swim on Mondays and Wednesdays and the south section to swim on Tuesdays and Thursdays. No activities are planned on registration day or for the following Monday, July 4.

The north section will attend a Tiger ball game on Saturday, July 2 and visit the Zoo on July 8. The south section will see the Tigers play on Saturday, July 16 and make the trek to the Zoo on Friday, July 22.

A combined trip to Bob-Lo Island is planned for both groups on Aug. 5.

On swimming days the buses will load at the playgrounds between 8:20 and 8:45 a.m. Children must bring their own lunches and canvas bag for their clothing. Provisions have been made for the children to buy milk at a cost of 10 cents. Buses will return at 3 p.m.

There will be playground activities on opposite days from a swim in. These days will begin at 10 a.m. and last till 3 p.m. with children returning home for lunch at 12 noon. Craft's and athletic games make up the non-swim days.

There is no charge for the regular activities of the program; the Tiger ball game is free as well. The Zoo trip will cost 25 cents for the train ride and "chip" show. The cost of the Bob-Lo boat ride will be 75 cents for youngsters 12 years and under, and \$1.75 for those 12 to 15 years of age. This does not include the cost of entertainment on the Island.
