More Homes Being Built This Year

The number of new residential units permitted in Wayne County during the first six months of 1966 showed an 8 percent gain over the corresponding 1965 period.

Figures just released by the Detroit Metropolitan Area Regional Planning Commission in its semi-annual report on housing authorizations, revealed that Wayne County permitted 5,014 units in the first half of 1966 as compared to 4,638 during the comparable 1965 period.

Significant Wayne County's increase is attributed to a higher incidence of multi-family activity. While permits for multiple units increased from 1,870 to 2,374 units, single family permits dropped by 142 units.

Broken down by area, the list of permits issued shows:

Ford Labor-Payroll Set All-Time Highs

Ford Motor Company worldwide employment and payrolls for the first half of 1966 were at the highest levels of any six-month period in the company's history.

Ford reported that its U.S. operations and subsidiaries around the world employed an average of 382,674 men and women during the first half of the year—21,571 more than the 361,103 employed in the comparable 1965 period. Worldwide payrolls of \$1,391,368,000 were up more than \$108 million from the 1965 first-half figure of \$1,283,158,000.

Ford U.S. employment (including Philco Corporation) reached a record average of 230,607 in the first half of 1966—up 15,780 from an average of 214,827 men and women employed a year ago. Nearly 7,700 of the employment increase was in Michigan.

Ford U.S. payrolls (also including Philco) rose to a record \$1,092,993,000 in the January-June period. This was more than \$80,000,000 higher than the \$1,012,457,000 paid to employees in the first six months of 1965.

Gross average hourly earnings of \$3.42 for Ford's U.S. hourly rated employees also set a record for the period. The comparable 1965 figure was \$3.56.

I-H Opens New Facility in Farmington

Underground System Boosts Lawn, Seedlings

How can you help assure survival of new lawn seedlings?

An underground watering system is one means.

There is a do-it-yourself plastic system on the market.

The plastic pipe and sprinkler heads should be laid out on the lawn before being buried.

This permits a check on the spray pattern.

The system is hooked into a regular outdoor faucet and is activated by a time clock that turns the sprinklers on and off.

Such a system is good for bentgrass turfs, which need more attention.

But it will give good watering control, especially in time of drought.
