

# Our Queen Offers Recipe for Super 'Home' Fudge Frosting

If you are a chocolate lover and/or a recipe collector, I have had news about last week's column.

If you clipped it, tear it up immediately, for both recipes contain previous errors. The pie recipe lacks baking information for the crust, and the eggs are still messed up for the mousse. Look for corrected recipes elsewhere in this paper.

The one was the typewriter's fault, it seems, and the other was the fault of my own typewriter, I fear. (I must get it overhauled.)

To dismayed cooks who may already have tried the recipes, my humblest apologies are offered, chocolate covered.

## "HOME" FUDGE FROSTING

Stir together 1 1/4 cups milk, one tablespoon light corn syrup, three cups sugar, three squares unsweetened chocolate, and a dash of salt. When chocolate has melted, stop stirring and boil to soft ball stage.

When soft ball stage is reached, or 238 degrees on your candy thermometer, add three tablespoons of butter and 1 1/2 teaspoons vanilla. Beat to spreading consistency, and then spread immediately, or you will have yourself a pot of fudge, honey.

Women who have very little discipline, or none, where chocolate is concerned, have confided to me that they run into trouble with recipes that call for a bag of chocolate chips. They eat the chocolate chips, of course, nibbling as they measure the other ingredients. By the time they reach the point of adding the morsels, there isn't a bag left.

For those people, then, here is an excellent brownie recipe that uses just half a bag, or a little more if there happens to be a little more.

**CHOCOLATE CHIP BROWNIES:** Beat two eggs till foamy; gradually beat in one cup of sugar. Melt two squares of unsweetened chocolate and 1/2 cup butter over hot water and add to well beaten egg-and-sugar mixture. Blend well.

Sift together 1/2 cup flour, 1/2 teaspoon baking powder, and 1/4 teaspoon salt. Add to above mixture, mix well, and stir in one teaspoon vanilla. Add 1/2 cup chocolate chips and pour into greased 8"x8" pan.

Bake at 350 degrees for 25 minutes. Sprinkle powdered sugar over when baked, or frost with any old chocolate frosting. Or try a mocha

frosting, for differences.

## MOCHA FROSTING FOR BROWNIES

Beat together one cup sift-

ed confectioners' sugar, two tablespoons soft butter, one teaspoon powdered instant coffee, and one tablespoon hot water. If icing is too

thick, add a few drops of water. In my research on chocolate, I came upon a couple of interesting things. One

is that the ants that live somewhere outside my kitchen window are chocolate ants: they come in only when crumbs of chocolate

goodies are about. Scientists ought to be able to do a lot with that information. The other thing is a sentence from the World Book
