## FHS Poet Sells Volumes of Volumes

Madge Hildebrandt, Farmington High grad of 1966, will soon become the community's newest published author.

Her book, "The Forever Wing," will be privately printed. The publication date has been set for March 1.

An advance sales campaign of the book was held December 21 at FHS. At this time 115 copies were ordered by students and faculty members. The aim of the sales campaign is just to break even. No one will be making any money at all, and Madge will subsidize part of the cost. After publication the price of the book will be 75 cents.

Miss Hildebrandt, freshman at the University of Michigan, wrote the work during her senior year of high school. Mr. Lee S. Peel, English and journalism teacher, said of her

poetry, "The work has high literary merit and deserves publication and this is the reason I have encouraged her to go ahead in order to gain a wider audience."

Of the advance sales campaign Mr. Peel said, "Its success reflects a considerable interest on the part of Farmington High students and faculty members in student literary works."

Miss Hildebrandt commented, "I'm overwhelmed by the enthusiasm and support which I am receiving in this project. The cover design and silk screening job is being handled by one of Farmington Senior High's art classes under the direction of Mrs. Ruby Glick."

Two of the student sales representatives have read the manuscript and commented on it. Garf Dunn stated, "An unusually fine attempt to deal with youthful emotions... refreshing."

Vicki Gilbert said, "Her poetry accurately mirrors the moods and and tempo of youth. You identify."
