SECTION XI. Reckless Driving.

vehicle upon property for which this Ordinance applies, carelessly and heedlessly in willful or wanton disregard of the safety of persons or property, or in violation of any law or ordinance regulating traffic upon the highways of the state may be operated on properties belonging to the Community College District.

without due caution of others, and without due regard for the safety of the public, and the driver of such vehicle shall be deemed to be negligent for the same.

SECTION XIX. License Reckless Driving.

Motor vehicles may be of various types, and the provisions of this Ordinance are applicable only by persons possessing a valid operator's license or permit to operate a motor vehicle of the same type as that required by the Department of State, or State, with which the State of Michigan has reciprocal license provisions.

SECTION XX. Prohibitive Parking.

No person shall park a vehicle in any of the following places:

1. On a sidewalk.
2. Within fifteen feet of any driveway.
3. Within an intersection."
4. Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant or instructional building.

On a designated crosswalk.

(a) It is a misdemeanor for any person to drive or move a vehicle on a highway without the owner's permit to be driven.

7. At any place at any time when official signs prohibit parking.

(b) Any police officer may be authorized on any reasonable grounds shown to stop any motor vehicle and inspect the same, and if any defect is found, to require the owner to repair the same.

SECTION XII. Brakes.
Every motor vehicle when operated on properties for which this Ordinance applies shall be equipped with brakes adequate to control the movement of the vehicle.

All brakes shall be maintained in good working order

and shall be so adjusted so as to operate as equally as practicable with respect to the wheels on the opposite side of the vehicle.

SECTION XXII. Removal.

(b) The engine and power mechanism of every motor vehicle shall be so equipped and adjusted as to prevent the escape of excessive fumes or

SECTION XVI. Mirrors.
No person shall drive a motor vehicle on properties for

which this Ordinance applies where said motor vehicle is so constructed or loaded as to prevent the driver from obtaining a view of the area to the rear of the vehicle, and

the rear by looking backward from the driver's position, unless such vehicle is equipped with a mirror so located as to

reflect to the driver a view of the area to the rear of such vehicle. Every commercial vehicle of $\frac{1}{2}$ ton capacity or more, shall be equipped with 2 mirrors, one on each side, consumed on roadways or parking areas established upon property for which the Ordinance applies.

SECTION XXV. Severability Clause.

SECTION XVII. Windshields. (a) No person shall drive any motor vehicle with any sign, poster or other non-transparent material upon the windshield, sidepane or

front windshield, sidewings or side or rear windows of such window which obstructs the driver's clear view of the high-

any way or purposes for which this Ordinance applies, or with any dangling ornament or other suspended object except as authorized by law which in any way obstructs the vision of or interferes with the safe operation of any vehicle, or which is so placed, attached or used as to constitute an offense under any other law, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$100.

(b) The windshield on every vehicle shall be equipped with a device for cleaning rain.

Each act committed in violation of the provisions hereof shall be deemed a separate offense and shall be punishable accordingly.

(c) Every windshield wiper on the motor vehicle shall be maintained in good working order.

(d) No motor vehicle operated as such, and manufactured after January 1, 1956, shall be operated on the properties for which this Ordinance applies unless it is equipped with a

windshield washer maintained in operable condition at all times and capable of cleaning
