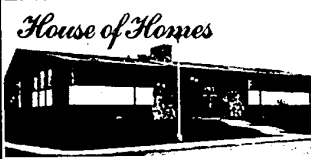

LEGAL NOTICES

AMENDMENT NO. 182 TO SEWER CONNECTION CHARGE ORDINANCE IS THE TOWNSHIP OF FARMINGTON ORDAINS:

A. That Paragraph 1. of Sewer Connection Charge Ordinance adopted May 26, 1959, and effective June 5, 1959, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

"I. That no parcel of property within the Township of Farmington shall hereafter be connected with any public sewer or drain until the owner thereof shall have first obtained a permit for such connection and shall have paid to the Township Treasurer a connection charge computed as follows:

(a) For each One-Family Dwelling located or to be located upon such parcel of property, the sum of \$350.00. "One Family Dwelling" shall mean a building designed exclusively for and occupied exclusively by one family for residential purposes.

(b) For other than One-Family Dwellings a sum to be fixed by resolution of the Township Board, in determining such sum, the Board shall give due consideration to the relative benefits to be obtained by the particular type of occupancy involved, by the availability of sewage disposal facilities as compared to the benefit obtained by a single One-Family Dwelling, but not limited to, the relative amounts of sanitary sewage to be discharged into the sewer system.

B. This amendatory ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its publication in the Farmington Enterprise, Farmington, Michigan.
