Tornado Mos., April, May, June

April, May and June are months of maximum tornado danger in Michigan, according to the Michigan Weather Service, which keeps Tornado records and plots the paths of expected danger.

Next most dangerous tornado months are March, July and August.

No tornadoes have ever been recorded in Michigan in November, December or January according to the weather service, which is operated in conjunction with the Michigan Department of Agriculture.

A HIGHLY accurate forecasting system generally gives three to five hours of warning. By tracking winds aloft with radar equipped balloons, the path of tornadoes can be predicted with 90 per cent accuracy.

Tornadoes occur when cold and violent winds of the upper atmosphere, sometimes up to 200 miles per hour or more, cross the path of warm, moisture-laden winds near the earth's surface. Drastic differences of air pressure at the intersection cause a whirling vortex, the tornado funnel.

A house or building near the funnel may literally explode outward, due to the vacuum created as air rushes upward in the core of the tornado funnel.

Star Projector Trip To Moon Takes Viewers

EAST LANSING - A simulated trip to the moon provided by a newly updated star projector is in store for visitors to Michigan State University's Abrams Planetarium.

The current program, "Countdown to the Moon," is the first in the planetarium's assumed schedule of public programs. It will be presented during April and May each Friday at 8 p.m., Saturday at 2:30 p.m. and 8 p.m., and Sunday at 2:30 p.m. and 4 p.m.

Dr. Thomas H. Osmond, director of the planetarium, said the star-projecting instrument is "one of the newest and most complex instruments" of its kind, reproducing more than 6,000 stars and the planets in their correct brightness, color and motions.

The new program takes visitors on a trip to the moon as though they were aboard an Apollo spacecraft. It includes illustrated views of early, fictional trips to the moon, plus "A Half Century of Space Exploration."

Around the funnel, for as much as a quarter of a mile, swirling winds may reach ground velocities of up to 300 miles per hour. All the while, the funnel ships across the land at speeds upwards of 20 miles per hour.

While modern records seem to indicate a growing frequency of tornadoes, weather service officials point out that this is probably due to better reporting, rather than any great increase in tornado activity.

Children Lack Social Contacts

EAST LANSING - A noted Cornell University psychologist, maintaining that "children used to be brought up by their parents," recently told a Michigan State University audience that today's child lives in a sterile world with fewer adults and less variety in social contacts.

Dr. Urie Bronfenbrenner said today the responsibility for bringing up children today "has shifted to other segments of society."

As a result, he noted, children's values and standards "are those of their peer culture, an autonomous agent practically free of adult influence."
