Wallpaper Answers Problems
Ready to remodel—but the budget is tight? Wallpaper can be the answer. Quality colors and patterns are now available for as low as 50¢ a roll, and many patterns are factory trimmed and pasted for quick, easy "do-it-yourself" application.

For those who have never put up wallpaper before, local dealers will be happy to give simple directions. However, many wall papers on the market today include hanging instructions in each roll.

There's variety, too, in the ways to remodel with wallpaper. For instance, many older homes and some newer ones have bad walls.

No amount of plastering will hide cracks, and with dry wall construction, seams are bound to show.

Wallpaper is one way to disguise these faults.

Since quality wall papers are washable, and colors won't fade, the decorating is done for as long as the family likes to keep a pattern.

When plaster walls are rough and uneven, one solution is to use a heavier paper, such as a paper-backed vinyl or a plastic-coated paper.

These papers come in a wide variety of patterns, especially designed for bathrooms and kitchens.

In a bath, the choice might be a design with butterflies, fish, mermaids, zodiac signs or even one with puddles.

For a kitchen, there are herb patterns, and others with tiles, drizzles, stained glass bottles and spice shelves.

Floral this year come in bright, clear colors and tone-on-tone effects that can be used in any room in the house.

They are found in modern, traditional or provincial patterns.

If walls of living or dining room have a one-color effect, consider a complete change of background color, with a scenic wallpaper to give added dimension to one of these rooms.

Create Designs With Diagonal Fabric Weaves

Interesting design can be created with fabrics having diagonal weaves. Michigan State University textile and clothing specialists suggest that diagonals are most effective in designs that:

1. Have a diagonal—ragged or kimono leaves create difficulty, and cannot be used unless accompanied by a special cutting chart.
2. Have slim skirts—gored or flared skirts will generally have bias edges which will force the diagonal to run in different directions.
3. Have a simple classic line—clothes which have many pattern pieces or intricate seaming details will create a multitude of problems in order to keep the diagonal lines going in one direction.

The primary rule to remember when selecting a pattern for your diagonal fabrics is to avoid bias cut seams or bias bands which will show on the right side.

Low Window Garden Fine

If the end wall of your living room lies close to the property line where large windows might create a privacy problem, try placing a window at the corner of the room, designed from floor to waist height and about six feet in width.

Panel the rest of the wall in incense cedar boards installed vertically, then plan a garden of dwarf pines and low shrubs outside the pedicab window. The effect can be terrific.

Insecticide May Dull Car Finish

In an effort to stop the westward spread of the Cereus Leaf Beetle, plans are being used to spray insecticide over thousands of acres of wheelstands.

All exposed cars should be washed promptly with soap or detergent suds because such sprays can dull the finish on automobiles.

Show on Wheels Scheduled Here

Homeowners in Observer-land will have the opportunity to see the latest in home comfort equipment when The Detroit Edison Company sets up its traveling electric heat show at Westland Center.

Already visited by over 300,000 Southeastern Michigan residents, the mobile display is expected to be more popular than ever with the in-electric heating for the increased interest being shown here, according to G. S. Zilly, Edison District Sales Manager.

"The show is for everybody," he said.

"The general public, electrical contractors and other interested persons are welcome to spend five minutes or an hour getting the facts about electric heat," he added.

Seven different types of electric heating equipment are on display. Most are operational. Visitors to the show can experience the instant response of electric heat for themselves by adjusting the thermostats which are mounted as they would be at home. Humidity control devices also are displayed.

All exhibits are built into surroundings that are home like. Ten manufacturers are co-operating in the displays which include a heat pump, baseboards, wall panels, ceiling panels and cables, and warm air systems.

Show dates are Oct. 10-15, according to Mr. Zilly and the times are 9:30-3 Monday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday.

Introduce Bonus Savings
