

St. Genevieve's Plan Worship Building

The fish, ancient symbol of Christ, is the powerful expression of St. Genevieve's Church, rising in Livonia.

Expansive wooden arches forming the structural ribs of the slate and copper roof caps huge curving brick walls that form this unique plan.

Tall and narrow slits of stained glass windows penetrate this subdued interior. The interior will be masculine and rich in warmth through the use of heavy granite, brick and wood.

Although 1300-400 attend Mass, the Church is designed to appear intimate by the use of sloping amphitheatre aisles. No one will be more than 70 feet from the sanctuary.

The Baptistry, heretofore apart from the main body of the church, is located directly in the Nave where all will pass and see.

Scheduled for completion next summer, the church will eliminate growth beginning in 1959 when Fr. Ferdinand Walber, Pastor, was directed to begin the parish.

Architect Joseph St. Cyr envisions the Church as a "vital place, the House of the People of God."

There is nursery service available for preschoolers, 2 to 5 years old. Mrs. Bernice Delawski, a highly qualified and experienced nurse, will work with the children. A fee of \$1.00 per week per family will be charged each week for this service.
