

Recreation Dept. Offers Program

The Winter program including basketball clinics for boys and girls, hockey, and activities for adults and seniors has been announced by the Westland Parks and Recreation Department.

Director John H. Voss pointed out that the boys and girls basketball will start next week for those in fifth through eighth grades. Instruction in fundamentals and skills will be offered during the five-week program.

Fifth and sixth grade boys will meet at 8:30 p.m. to 7:45 p.m. at the following schools on a specific day: Adams on Wednesdays; Nankin Mills on Tuesdays; Monroe on Tuesdays; Henry Ford on Wednesdays; and Cady on Mondays.

Seventh and eighth grade boys will meet on Tuesdays at the Marshall school from 7:45 to 9 p.m.

The girls will meet at Adams on Mondays; Nankin Mills on Thursdays; Coper on Wednesdays; and Stottlevener on Thursdays. The time schedule will be the same as for the boys clinics.

BOYS HOCKEY will be held in pee wee, bantam, midget, and juvenile teams in the Suburban Hockey League in Garden City and a Squirt team in Dearborn. The age divisions are as follows: squirt, under ten years of age, as of May 31, 1966; pee wee, under 12; bantam, under 14; midget, under 16; and juvenile, under 18.

BOYS interested in playing hockey this winter are advised to fill out and return the forms at the end of the story to the Westland Parks and Recreation Office.

A RIFLE CLUB will be offered if enough interest is shown while pinocle will be held every Thursday night at 8 p.m. at Recreation Center, 32715 Dorset Road.

Senior citizens are invited to join the Happy Hour Club, to meet at noon Mondays in the Recreation Center. Activities will include trips, later parties, mystery trips

card games and other special games and activities.

A MEN'S gym class will be offered from 7-10 p.m. every Monday at the Nankin Mills Junior High starting Nov. 21. Registration fee is \$5.

Women's gymnastics and volleyball will be held from 7:30-10 p.m. every Wednesday at the Marshall Junior High. Registration fee is \$5.

Men's basketball for those over 18 years of age will be held every Wednesday night at the Nankin Mills Junior High with league competition to start in early January. Entry fee may be paid at the recreation office.

Teen-age dances will be scheduled for each Friday night at the Recreation Center starting Nov. 18.

Garden City Test High LSD Program Set for Nov. 16

LSD, that controversial, much-talked about, mind-altering drug, will be the topic of discussion at the Westland High School next Wednesday, Nov. 16.

At the monthly meetings, interesting speeches given by doctors, clergymen, and other interested laymen who are concerned with teen age problems. They consider LSD a most vital issue. So should you.

The students at West voted Monday for the candidates and, through parent-teacher discussions and open forums, these problems are being dealt with. Among the members of this organization, smoking, and dropping out of school.

Featured speakers will be Dr. Robert Zander, a medical psychiatrist at the State Clinic, L. L. Mearns, a clinical psychologist with Wayne County General Hospital, and a representative of the Food and Drug Administration, who will discuss the legal aspects relative to the various uses of LSD.

Dr. Zander and Mearns will speak of the dangers, therapeutic possibilities, and future potentialities of the drug.

Also taking part in the evening's discussion will be James Treloar, Detroit Free Press reporter, who on an account of Wayne State University students and their experiences with LSD, will present the student's viewpoint on the uses of the drug as well as the drawbacks encountered by them while taking LSD.

This program, arranged by Mrs. Priscilla W. L. and Mrs. Louise Hamilton, is to be presented as a public service, and will begin at 8 p.m. in the cafeteria of West High School.
