

Lawrence Tech To Host 1,700 JAs

A two-day conference of officers from Junior Achievement companies on Saturday, Dec. 3, and Saturday, Dec. 10 will attract approximately 1,700 teenagers to the campus of Lawrence Institute of Technology, West Ten Mile and Northwestern, in Southfield.

The purpose of the Junior Achievement Management Conference (JAMCO) is to provide the youth an opportunity to meet and work with fellow achievers and advisers, and to meet and work with business and industry executives. One of the goals: To learn what careers are available in business and industry.

The Dec. 3 meeting will include these JA officers—presidents, corporate secretaries, treasurers, personnel directors, and assistants. On Dec. 10, these officers are invited: vice presidents of sales and manufacturing; safety directors; purchasing managers; and assistants.

The young business people will come from Wayne, Oakland, Macomb, Livingston, and Monroe Counties. All are high school juniors or seniors. In charge of an information center during the two days will be J. L. Martin, of Junior Achievement of Southeastern Michigan.

Hare Bemoans Delays In Driver Convictions

LANSING—Even though more than 50 per cent of the traffic violations committed in Michigan are settled within one month from arrest to conviction, many linger on for months . . . 20 per cent remaining unsettled from eight weeks to a year or longer.

A study of 47,000 cases by the Michigan Department of State, revealed that nearly 30 per cent of these cases were dispatched by the courts within one week of arrest, Secretary of State James M. Hare said.

"This is good. But on the other hand," said Hare, "18 per cent are prolonged for more than 10 weeks, with nearly five per cent delayed a year or longer."

Hare said the analysis pointed up the "dire need of adopting a ticket system like the one in Illinois."

"Under the Illinois system, when a driver commits a moving violation, the police officer picks up his driver's license and issues him a
