Michigan State Police of-ficers made 22,275 arrests in October, 20,009 of them for traffic offenses and 2,666 on

trainic offenses and 2,000 on criminal complaints, accord-ing to the department's monthly activity report. In addition, 750 juvenile traffic offenders were arrest-ed and 694 delinquent minors and one wayward minor ap-prehended.

Troopers assisted 5,798 motorists, investigated 10,772 cars, issued 23,531 oral warnings to drivers, and made 13,123 property and 2,011 liquor inspections.
