Two Area Names Listed Among Outstanding Women of 1966

Two young mothers in this area, Mrs. Donald Sefton of Garden City and Mrs. David Pachota of Livonia, are listed in the 1966 edition of "Outstanding Young Women of America."

The book is an annual biographical compilation of 4,000 outstanding women between the ages of 21 and 35 who have distinguished themselves in civic and professional activities.

Mrs. Sefton has been active in local political and school affairs. Two years ago she was publicity director in Garden City Councilman Robert Wilk's successful bid for office, and served as campaign manager for John D. Perry when he was elected to the Garden City school board in June of 1965.

Mrs. Sefton lives at 2846 Sheridan with her husband and two children, eight-year-old Kendrick and Ann, six.

Mrs. Pachota, one of seven Madonna College alumnae included in the book, is a former teacher and mother of three. She has worked as publicity director in the altar society of St. Genevieve Church and won writing awards and had several magazine articles published while she was in college.

She lives at 14990 Miller and her youngsters are Edward, four; Susan, three; and Ann Marie, one.

Other Madonna College alumnae chosen included Valerie Gniwiew of Detroit, Christina Kary of Midland, Mrs. Frank Scheuer of Grosse Ile, Mrs. Thomas Stalback of Taylor, Mrs. Donald Westover of Bay City and Mrs. Peter Wujkowski of Saginaw.

The women were recommended for the honor by the college and selected by the Board of Advisory Editors of the publication.

Mrs. Lyndon B. Johnson, who serves as honorary chairman of the Board of Advisory Editors for the publication, has said the book is especially meaningful to her because the achievements and abilities of women is a subject close to her heart.

United States Senator Margaret Chase Smith, in her introductory message to the 1966 edition of "Outstanding Young Women of America," said, "This book calls attention to the great capabilities of our young women and their ability to get things done."

The publication was conceived by the leaders of the nation's women's clubs. They felt that young women who give their time for community projects should be recognized. The recognition of these outstanding women can serve to inspire others to give their time to additional civic responsibilities.

Local women's clubs throughout the country submit nominations for the book each year. Guidelines for selection include unselfish service to others, charitable activities, personal excellence, business advancement, and civic and professional recognition. The book is 7 by 10 inches in size and contains 880 pages.
