Zetablished six years ago, the Committee for Foster Children assists in developing programs to inform the public about foster home care to encourage more volunteers as foster parents. During 1965 a daily average of more than 2,500 children were living in foster homes in Wayne, Oakland and Macomb counties. The committee's experience has shown that a minimum of 300 new foster homes is needed annually
