Piano Teachers Institute Slated

Internationally known composer and pianist Victor Babin will conduct the sixth annual Piano Teachers Institute at Oakland University this year. Dr. Babin will work with brilliant young area pianists in a master class demonstration at the 8-day program, scheduled for Friday, April 7.

Appearing with Dr. Babin, director of the Cleveland Institute of Music since 1961, will be Mrs. Teruko Nishida, a pianist of Bloomfield Hills; the Weintraub twins, Joyce and Joanne; and Barbara Usas, of Detroit.

Members of musical and study groups, piano teachers and their pupils and professional pianists have been invited to the Institute which is co-sponsored by the Division of Continuing Education and the Music Department of Oakland University.

Dr. David DiChiera, acting chairman of the music department, will welcome the delegates following 9 a.m. registration at the Oakland Center.

Tuition for the entire day is \$10 which includes tuition, registration and lunch. Balance of the cost is being underwritten by the Mott Foundation.
