## Futurist Collection Goes to Art Institute

The largest single collection in the world of drawings and prints by Umberto Boccioni, central figure of the Italian Futurist movement, will be shown for the first time in its entirety at the Detroit Institute of Arts.

Mrs. Lydia Winston Malbin has given the Institute a permanent loan of this collection.

The comprehensive exhibition—"The Lydia Winston Malbin Collection of Boccioni Drawings"—will open April 28 and continue through May 28. The drawings will be accompanied by Boccioni's related sculpture and paintings, also from the Winston collection.

Ellen Sharp, curator of Graphic Arts, describes the loan—263 drawings, 42 etchings—as "incomparable in quantity and quality." Boccioni's graphics are not merely preliminary sketches for future work in other media, but strong independent entities," she states.

The exhibition will be previewed by Founders members Tuesday evening, April 23, following a lecture sponsored by the Drawing and Print Club at 8 p.m. The lecture is open to the public without charge. Marianne W. Martin, Associate Professor of Art History at Brandeis University, a leading Futurist scholar.

Mrs. Malbin and her late husband, Harry Lewis Winston, acquired the Boccioni material between 1955-1957. In 1961, they loaned a number of these items to the Museum of Modern Arts, Futurism exhibition and New York Times art critic, John Canaday, wrote, "these collectors own close to two-thirds of the known total (Boccioni).

graphics in the world. Their acquisition was a collectors' coup... futurist art and other art connectable with futurism's spirit, which is one of lyrical expression by way of analytical method. Boccioni came closest to perfecting this difficult synthesis and the Winstons acquired some of his major works."
