Northville Girl Is Among Betty Crocker Leaders

Joyce Elaine Stuckey, a student at Northville High School, won honorable mention in the 1967 Michigan competition for the Betty Crocker Homemaker of Tomorrow crown.

First place in the state contest went to Janet Elizabeth Lewis of Edsel Ford High School, Dearborn, who received a \$1,500 scholarship from General Mills, and Barbara Ann Wilson, Swartz Creek, won second place and a \$500 scholarship.

Competing in the home-making tests were 23,206 senior girls in 557 of the state's high schools.

Awards were based on the 13th annual written Betty Crocker Knowledge and Attitude examination, prepared and scored by Science Research Associates, Chicago.

Miss Lewis now is eligible, with homemakers from the other 49 states and the District of Columbia, for All-American Homemaker of Tomorrow honors.

Westland F.D. Off to Fast Start in 1967

Westland's Fire Department, which broke all department activity records in 1966, started off the new year last month at a hot pace.

Firemen responded to 123 alarms in January, equivalent to the monthly average of the previous year when a record 1,456 runs were made. This broke the 1965 record of 1,087 by nearly a 40 per cent mark.

Last month, firemen answered 85 rescue calls from citizens as compared to only 42 during the corresponding month in 1966.

Another indication of the department's activity is a short note which shows that there were five double alarms in January, when two fire calls were received at the same time, and one triple alarm.

The fire losses for the past month amounted to \$12,360, less than one half of the \$25,880 figure of the same month last year. There were also three personal injuries reported in January fires as compared to one the corresponding period in 1966.

In the breakdown of the actual 32 calls in January, 20 were in buildings, six in vehicles, and two in rubbish near buildings.

In other department statistics for the month, 17 inspections were made by the fire prevention bureau following 13 complaints received. One violation was found and a notice was issued.

Two other violations were corrected during the month. A dozen talks were given before audiences with a total number of 402 persons in attendance.
