A sub-committee was named to study the need for an auditorium and make recommendations to the whole committee.

The sub-committee then recommended that the audit-orium should be considered as a theater plus two large-group instruction areas. The main floor of the theater for drama, speech, muste, class assemblies, etc. will provide 200 years and an adequate stage area.

Large group instruction areas will be placed in a balcony and be to designed as to include two spaces divided. to include two spaces divided by partitions for 150 seals e.ch. This baleony area will be used on a daily basis for scheduled classes in social studies, English, science, etc., and will be used for solid and community events when-ever more than 800 seals are required.

Recause this suditorium will be used by students and sdults in the evenings, the subcommended that separate entrances from the remainder of the school will be needed and the facility should be located near a parking area.

school. The health office will con-sist of a nuise's office, a small students reception seria and a dispensary or examin-ing room. The health suite will contain a separate boys, and girls' cot room of 50 square feet, for sick or mjur-ed students.

In the lunch room or food service faculty the idea of a single large room for lunches has been done away with in favor of three smaller facil-ities which throughout the day can be used for other activities.

One of these spaces will be used as a study hall area. The second space will be used as a large-group instruction space when not being used for lunch. The third space will be called a student commons area where students may gather before, during and after the school day. This space will be located near the gym.




