

## You Can Dance Every Evening

Three big public dances are planned for each of the three nights of the Founders Festival. A teen dance, which is expected to attract as many as 1,500, is scheduled for 9 p.m. to midnight Thursday. Sponsored by the Farmington Area Teen Age Council of the YMCA, it will feature Dick Purdin, disc jockey for WKNR.

The dance will be held in East Junior High School, at the corner of Middle Belt and 11 Mile Rd. Cost will be 50 cents for FAYAC members and \$1 for others. All teen-agers over 15 are invited.

A COMMUNITY-wide two-in-one dance will be held in Demery's Center parking lot Friday night.

Sponsored by the Farmington Township Police Association, the community dance will provide two bands, the "Us Guys," and George Alzano's quartet.

The Township Police hope that by employing two bands they will be able to keep two generations happy.

The community dance is free, and is planned to last from 9 p.m. until midnight. In case of rain, the activities will be shifted to O.E. Dunckel Junior High School, on 12 Mile Rd. SATURDAY night's square dance is sponsored by the City of Farmington.

Set for 9 p.m. at Downtown Farmington Center, the dance will feature Harley Woods as caller. He has agreed to donate his time.

The dance is open to everyone, and there is no admission charge.

## Rump GOP Group Sets Teen Show

A conservative-leaning Republican group in the 19th Congressional District is seeking to give itself a youthful look by sponsoring a "giant combo clash" for teenage musical groups.

The group is the rump GOP organization headed by West Bloomfield Justice of the Peace Christian F. Powell, whose organization continued in business even though the state Republican convention last winter refused to seat his delegation and does not recognize its officers.

The combo clash is scheduled for West Bloomfield High School Sunday, Aug. 6, from 7 to 10:30 p.m. Eight teen groups will ap-

pear, according to Robert Papenuth of Orchard Lake, chairman of the group's special events committee.

### Ford Sales

Ford Division's July 1-10 passenger car and truck daily sales rate was the second highest for the period in Division history.

Preliminary figures show the combined 6,547 car and truck daily selling rate for the first July reporting period exceeded last year's 6,333 rate. Car sales totaled 33,907, for a 4,844 daily rate and trucks 11,920, for a 1,703 rate. The truck total set a record for the period.

In addition, the group is preparing a directory of teen musical groups which will be distributed the evening of the combo clash.

Powell's group attracted state attention when it was ousted from its state convention seats because of irregularities in the conduct of the district convention. The GOP State Central Committee recognizes the moderate organization headed by John Cartwright, a West Bloomfield attorney, as the legal 19th District organization.
