Grievance Remains Unsettled**Legislative Chairman Named**

South Redford School Trustee Richard Guregian will serve as the district's legislative chairman, succeeding Trustee Douglas Mueller who has held the post for two years.

He will also serve as alternate delegate to the annual meeting of the Michigan Association of School Boards to be held Sept. 19, 20 and 21 at Cobo Hall.

Board Secretary Jeanne Leonard will be the delegate. Both were appointed last week by the board of education.

In other business, the board:

• Learned that the grievance relating to Joseph M. Zawadzki, who felt he should have been granted a sabbatical leave, has been returned to Level Five which is consideration by the board.

Because of a hassle over time, it had moved up to Level Six.

The board will seek an opinion from its attorney before giving further consideration.

• Learned that the hot lunch program was \$280 in the red at the end of May.

• Referred a communication to the district's insurance company and attorney, pertaining to an injury accident at Rogers School where a child ran into a chain.

• Heard Assistant Supt. Joseph Rzepka explain that improvements are being made on the new tennis

courts at Thureton where the contractor's work has been under fire. School officials are also asking the contractor to improve grading.

• Learned that consideration is still being given to selecting the firm to handle group insurance. A committee headed by Henry McCurry, has recommended switching from the present carrier, Mutual Benefit Life, affiliated with the Michigan Education Association, to another, Washington National.

Schmidt Hits MSU Tuition Hike Formula

Rep. Louis E. Schmidt has joined other House members in co-sponsoring a resolution asking the Michigan State University Board of Trustees to abandon its new sliding scale tuition plan.

He called the tuition plan "discriminatory and in direct violation of the concept of state support for colleges and universities."

The resolution, signed by Schmidt points out that the unique plan is unworkable and undoubtedly constitutionally objectionable, and urges the university to revise its tuition plan. The resolution suggested that M.S.U. should either adopt an across-the-board fee increase or make adjustments in individual tuition based on a set amount, rather than determined by family income and a sliding ability-to-pay scale.

Pastor To Head Youth Group

Rev. Donald C. Starenko, pastor of Faith Lutheran Church, 30000 Five Mile Road, is the new chairman of the Livonia Youth Commission.

He was elected by members of the commission to replace Mrs. Helen A. Tadonilo, who is resigning from the commission as of August 31. Pastor Starenko has served on the commission for about two years.
