

Delay Of Road Safety Measures Irks James Hare

LANSING — Secretary of State James M. Hare has defined the legislature's work in traffic safety as "good but limited... with several key measures enacted."

Hare said the lawmakers "did some strong ground-work in the safety area, much of it involving unglamorous but important programs not apparent to the public."

"However, I was keenly disappointed over the failure of certain measures to gain favorable action," Hare said, scoring periodic motor vehicle inspection, the so-called Illinois traffic ticket system, authority to deal with problem drivers on the basis of accident involvement, and establishment of a medical evaluation board as major omissions.

"I know the legislature had its hands full with revision of the state tax structure and that several key issues were not acted upon because of the unsettled fiscal situation," Hare said.

He said he was hopeful that Governor Romney would add traffic safety to his agenda for the proposed special session this fall.

Hare said he rated several measures as "glaring plusses" in the traffic safety area.

The most important, according to Hare, was implied consent. "Frankly, this was the major program which I would have predicted had the least chance of passage before the session started," he said. "I was most happy to see it enacted."

Also drawing praise from Hare was passage of several amendments to the Motor Vehicle Accident Claims Fund, most notably the one that henceforth will permit the Fund to retain all its collections.

"This will insure the solvency of the Fund and give the state a chance to invest this money in the future, using the interest to administer the Fund. Ontario, which has a similar program, invests its money, and administration of its program costs nothing out of general fund appropriations."

Another legislature-approved program was to provide enough money in the budget to accelerate mechanization of all driver vehicle records.

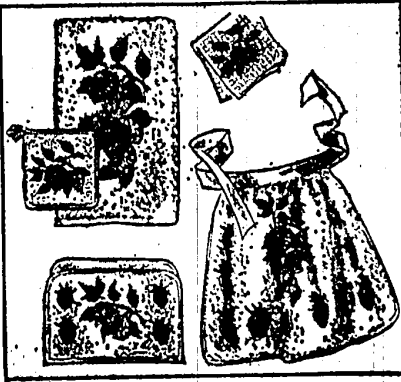
One measure, presently in conference committee, said Hare, actually was a "step backward." This was a bill to provide for an increase of 50 cents to driver license fees, with the additional money reverting to local examining operations.

"I have urged the Governor not to veto the bill if it is a hedge-podge and lacks uniformity in licensing standards," Hare reminded the Governor, that he (Romney) had been on record as favoring a state driver license examining system.

"Enactment of this bill certainly could be a body blow to Michigan's advance toward centralized licensing. It would encourage further splintering of a system which is a hodge-podge and lacks uniformity in licensing standards."
