



Helicopter Rides Are Feature

Helicopter rides featuring a view of Farmington from the air will be sponsored during the Farmington Founders Festival by the Farmington Board of Commerce.

The rides, provided by the Helicopter Airway Service, will leave from the athletic field at Our Lady of Sorrows during the three days of the Festival, Aug. 17, 18 and 19. Cost of the ride will be \$3. The Farmington Board of Commerce are the sponsors of the Festival. Through this activity it is seeking to raise some of the necessary funds for the cost of underwriting the three-day event.

You Can Dance Every Evening

Three big public dances are planned for each of the three nights of the Founders Festival. A teen dance, which is expected to attract as many as 1,500, is scheduled for 9 p.m. to midnight Thursday. Sponsored by the Farmington area Teen Age Council of the YMCA, it will feature Dick Purtin, disc jockey for WKNE.

The dance will be held in East Junior High School, at the corner of Middle Belt and 11 Mile Rd. Cost will be 50 cents for FATAC members and \$1 for others. All teen-agers over 15 are invited. A COMMUNITY-wide two-night dance will be held in Demery's Center parking lot Friday night.

Sponsored by the Farmington Township Police Association, the community dance will provide two bands, the "Us Guys," and George Alfano's quartet. The Township Police hope that by employing two bands they will be able to keep two generations happy. The community dance is free, and is planned to last from 9 p.m. until midnight. In case of rain, the activities will be sketched to G.E. Drunkel Junior High School, on 12 Mile Rd.

Mounted Police Set Performance

Farmington Township Mounted Police in action will be a major feature of the Founders Festival Horse Show set for Saturday at 1 p.m. The Mounted Police will have the place of honor at the head of the grand entry procession, followed by Farmington's 4-H Club, Los Caballeros.

A trophy and citation for community service will be presented to the police by the Farmington Masonic Temple Association, which is sponsoring the horse show. The Mounted Police organization was established a few years ago under the direction of Sgt. John Polder of the township police force. Since then, the riders have participated in parades all over this area and have also served the community in searches for lost children, rescue work and crowd control. They form a unit of the auxiliary police force.

Missile Is Parade Feature

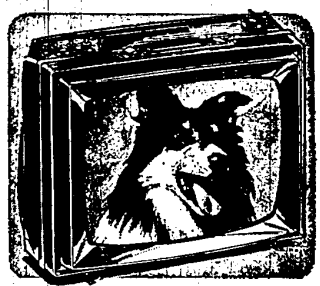
The missiles have a range of 75 nautical miles and are 71 feet long.

SATURDAY night's square dance is sponsored by the City of Farmington.

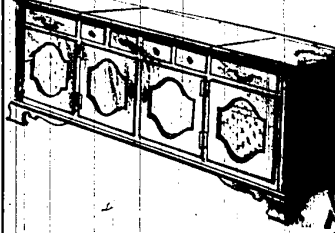
Set for 9 p.m. at Downtown Farmington Center, the dance will feature Harley Woods as caller. He has agreed to donate his time.

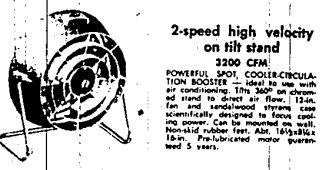

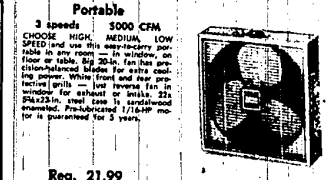
