

To Mediate Diamond Strike

Michigan's State Labor Mediation Board and federal Farmington Township's Diamond mediators have stepped into

Teamsters Local 814, bargaining agent for the plant's workers.

The Teamsters struck the plant Aug. 3 charging that the company has refused to participate in further bargaining since the work stoppage there have been no talks between the two teams.

A negotiation session was held Monday afternoon. No success was made following the session.

G. R. Wonnacott of the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service, and Leonard D. Bennett of the Michigan State Labor Mediation Board, were both present. The teamsters were represented by Joseph Bane, president of the local, and Steven Hudak, business agent. A labor attorney, Joseph Clark, represented management.

Teamsters spokesman said when the strike was called that it was seeking: "a decent wage, a pension plan, cost of living benefit, and a reclassification of benefit."
