## Twp. To Ease Assessments In One Home, Two Lot Case

Farmington Township is working out a policy to ease the special assessment burden on property owners whose lots have only one house but are large enough for two.

Under the policy, approved last week by the Township Board but still to be implemented by an ordinance amendment: "The township will agree to limit the special assessment—such as for water or sewer—to the rate for a single dwelling unit."

In return, the property owner agrees—and binds his heirs -- to pay an additional assessment if the use of his property is changed in the future to more than one dwelling unit.

The township has had a handful of tough cases of this sort. In a typical one a few weeks ago, an older couple owned an L-shaped lot that faces on a side street but also touches a main street.

A sewer is to be built on the main street; their house could be served by a line built across the back of the lot; but once another line is built on the side street, they would be assessed a second time.

The couple was uncertain whether or not they would ever sell off the part of the lot fronting on the main street. As long as the couple built intended to have only one house on the lot, they would, under the new policy, be assessed once. If they ever sold off the main street part of the lot or built a second house on it, however, they could then be assessed for the second benefit.
