Police Seek Witness

Farmington Township police would like to locate a woman who supposedly witnessed a fatal traffic accident at the intersection of Halstead and 12 Mile Rds. on Oct. 24.
Her view of just what occurred is important to the eventual disposition of the case, Inspector Russ Conway declared.
The officer added that the unidentified witness is said to have been driving a gray 1965 Oldsmobile, passing through the same intersection within seconds of the fatal crash. She did not stop, however, he said.
The accident claimed the life of Richard J. Zack, 20, of Lincoln Park, whose vehicle was northbound on Halstead when struck by one driven by Robert K. Spradling, of Northville. Spradling at the time was driving eastward on 12 Mile.
Any other unknown witnesses to the crash also are asked to volunteer their recollections of the accident to Township authorities.
