FHS Ticket Sale Begins Saturday

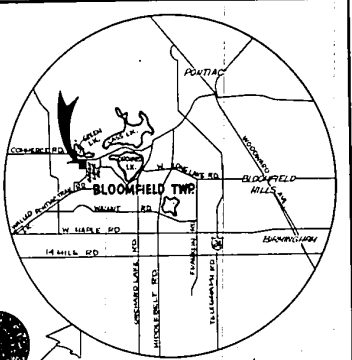

Later that afternoon, the troop marched in a parade with 15,000 Canadian Scouts.
