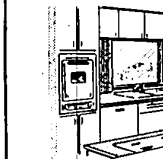

City Planners Seek Ordinance Review

To preserve the continuity between sections one and two of Chatham Hills Subdivision on Grand River near Drake Rd., Farmington city planning commissioners Monday night voted to recommend to the council a review of the city ordinance on street and alley widths. Chatham Hills developers received approval for 27-foot street widths in section one of the project before the acreage was annexed by the city.

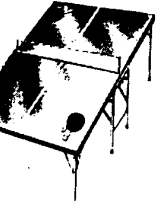
THE CITY ordinance requires wider streets which would make for complete non-conformity between the two adjoining sections. Planning commission opinion is that more realistic requirements might be provided by council for developments that have large lots. Chatham Hills lots run from a minimum of 90 feet, which contrasts with the average city size lot of 60 feet.

The commission also feels it has a moral obligation to the developers because the preliminary section is already platted with 27-foot wide streets.

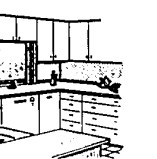
IN OTHER action, commissioners held a public hearing and set the date for another. The public hearing was held on a request for re-zoning for parking by the Telephone Company in connection with the company's expansion of its facility at Powers and Grand River.

Speaking for the company, Arnold Jensen said the request for zoning for parking is in line with the company's long range plans and also is to keep employees from parking on city streets.

The request was recommended to council for its approval.

Youths Fined And Put On Probation

Two Farmington Township youths, who admit beating a third boy of 16 with a chain after picking him up as a hitchhiker, have been fined and placed on probation by Justice of the Peace Byron Walter after a severe tongue lashing.

Judge Walter fined both Larry James Miller, 17, of 23446 Sans Souci, and Kurt Karl Corey, 18, of 21672 Purdue, \$100, plus \$15 court costs, for the Oct. 26 incident.

In addition, he placed Corey on probation for two years, and gave Miller one year's probation.

Both had originally entered pleas of not guilty to the charge of felonious assault, but reversed this when the accusation was reduced to simple assault upon their court appearance before Judge Walter.

They had picked the 16-year-old up in a car on 13 Mile Rd, while he was en route to a part-time job in the shopping center at 13 Mile and Orchard Lake, then beat him both with fists and a chain. The boy was treated for injuries at Providence Hospital.
