

# Cranbrook To Display Swedish Wood Items

"Living with Wood", an exhibition of contemporary and traditional design in Sweden, will open in Cranbrook Academy of Art Galleries Jan. 9 and remain on through Feb. 4.

The exhibition shows the many ways wood influences daily life in Sweden from buildings to furniture, tools and utensils, toys and games, musical instruments and sporting equipment. The show was organized by the Swedish Institute for Cultural Relations in cooperation with the Swedish Society for Industrial Design and is touring the country under the auspices of the Smithsonian

institution. DESIGNED to create an environment of its own, the display has 20 six-foot curved wooden panels mounted with photographs showing modern and traditional architecture and wooden objects in use. Over 200 three-dimensional objects of contemporary design are shown in such a way that the exhibit visitor is made to feel how completely wood dominates human existence in Sweden.

Objects selected range from furniture and sculpture to toys and household items. Many that in other countries might be made of ceramics, metal or plastic are in Sweden made of wood because of the designers' preference for the material. The children's toys are most appealing both for their whimsical design and their forms. Many of the other items are intended for daily use—chairs, bowls, spoons, cigarette boxes—where they give pleasure merely through touch.

THE TRADITIONS of woodworking in Sweden date back to the Vikings. From medieval times the rich farm culture encouraged the use of wood, available in abundance. Today Sweden still has the largest timberland in Europe and her contemporary designs in wood are used and imitated all over the world. The exhibition includes pieces by many of the country's foremost designers: chairs by Carl Malmsten and Bruno Mathsson, sculptures by Axel H. Petersson, "Doderhultarn" and by students of the Arts and Crafts School at Lidings. For comparison, old carvings from the Nordiska Museum and the Wassa Warship Museum and examples of traditional crafts by regional artisans have been included.
