### Sports Car Review Opens '68 Calendar

A full year of special activities at the Henry Ford Museum in Dearborn gets underway on Jan. 12 when the 16th annual "Sports Cars in Review" opens.

Outstanding examples of sporting machines from around the world, dating back to the turn of the century, will be displayed on the museum's Street of Early American Shops. The 50-odd cars represent seven nations and a wide variety of styling innovations and performance records.
