Colleges Ask Big Aid Boost

Anticipating a 5.3 per cent enrollment increase, Michigan's 11 public universities and colleges are asking for a 22.4 per cent increase in state aid.

R-S. Clair, chairman of the Senate Appropriations Committee, says the colleges want a total state appropriation of nearly \$271 million for the fiscal year that begins July 1.

Wayne State University is asking for an \$11.05 million budget increase to raise its total appropriation to \$44.50 million. Wayne State officials say they will have nearly 26,000 students next year, about 1,400 more than they have now.

CENTRAL has requested \$10.94 million, a \$3.37 million increase; Eastern \$16.45 million, a \$6.15 million increase; Ferris \$9.23 million, a \$2.45 million increase; Grand Valley \$2.63 million, a \$652,227 increase; Northern \$8.17 million, a \$3.05 million increase; Saginaw \$1.13 million, a \$632,210 million increase; and Western \$21.73 million, a \$6.85 million increase.

Benefit Hikes To Help 64,000 In The Suburbs

Social Security benefit increases will be added automatically into April checks received by 64,000 in northwest Detroit suburbs.

President Johnson signed the bill Jan. 2 providing benefit increases of at least 13 per cent.

SAM F. TEST, district manager for Social Security in the Detroit-Northwest office, said beneficiaries will not be required to take any action, that the increases will be made automatically.

This is just about equivalent to the value of all the private life insurance now in force. Under the amended law, maximum payments to families now on the Social Security benefit rolls will go up from the currently payable maximum of \$309.20 a month to \$322.40.

Residents of the northwest area can expect the first increased check on April 3.

The average benefit payable to a retired worker, about \$86, will be raised to \$98, an increase of \$12 a month. The average couple's benefit, now \$145, will go up to \$165; and the average aged widow's benefit will rise \$11, from the current average of \$75 to \$86.
