

Make A Game Room

Shuffleboard is a favorite game for young and old. It can be played in a basement of any size by simply putting down a shuffleboard surface with the markings and other markings already imprinted.

As a proper setting for this game, install a durable, attractive wall such as Masonite plywood, available in 17 patterns and woodgrains. A few comfortable chairs for spectators and a popper will make this a popular indoor game area.

TABLE TENNIS is another game inviting to all age groups. Even a small basement can accommodate a playing surface, especially if the ingenious handyman can store it out of sight between sessions.

One handyman, finishing his basement with prefinished hardwood panels, made several of them removable. Behind the wall is adequate space for storing the table tennis outfit, which has removable legs.
