Pitcairn Island Has Telephones

The telephone has come to Pitcairn Island, the small British colony in the Pacific first settled by the Mutineers of the HMS Bounty in 1790. According to "The World's Telephone," the annual statistical review released by the American Telephone and Telegraph Company, the 93 residents of the tiny mid-Pacific island are now served by a network of 15 phones. At the other end of the scale, the number of telephones in the United States rose to 98.8 million at the beginning of 1967--the 100 millionth phone was installed during the year--close to half of the world's total.

Establish Scholarship For Violinists

ANN ARBOR--A scholarship fund for violin students in the University of Michigan School of Music has been established in memory of Prof. Joseph F. Knitzer, internationally known concert violinist and teacher. Prof. Knitzer, a U-M faculty member since 1964, died last July 1 at age 53. Contributions are being accepted by the Office of School Relations, 2266 School of Music, on the University's North Campus. Knitzer was head of the violin department of the National Music Camp at Interlochen, for 10 years. His former students from Interlochen and other schools are now widely distributed among major symphony orchestras.

The volume of overseas calls also continued to soar. Calls between the U.S. mainland and overseas points totaled 9.9 million in 1966, up by 22 per cent over the preceding year. By the start of this year, Rumania had become the 31st country with a half-million or more phones. Japan followed the U.S. in the total number of phones with 16 million, leading the United Kingdom, West Germany, the USSR, Canada, France and Italy.

THIS COUNTRY retained its lead in telephones per 100 population with 49.5, Sweden was second with 47.5, followed by New Zealand, 39.2; Switzerland, 39.2; Canada, 38.9; and Denmark, 29.1. In telephone talk, however, Canada kept its world title, averaging 664 conversations per person during 1966. The U.S. again ran second, averaging 618. For the first time in several years, AT&T was able to include figures on Moscow. The Soviet capital has 850,000 telephones for its 6 1/2 million citizens, a ratio of 13.1 per 100 population. New York City, by way of comparison, has 67.1 per 100 population. AT&T said that the Moscow figures were obtained from one of the Press Wire Services.
