

Arnie's Army Gets Chance To Smile Again

Arnie's Army smiled again. They cheered as Arnold Palmer stormed from behind to win the Bob Hope Desert Classic for the third time.

First he had to sink a 20-foot birdie putt on the final hole of the 90-hole tourney to force a tie with Dea Beaman, fresh from the amateur ranks. Each had tied with 348, 12 under par.

In the playoff that followed, Palmer won with a par on the second extra hole when Beaman overran the green with his approach.

Harold Henning was third, 11 under par, while Billy Casper and Tom Weiskopf finished a stroke back. Casper had started the final day with a two-shot edge.

IT'LL BE Jimmy Ellis vs. Jerry Quarry in late March or April for the World Boxing Association's version of the heavyweight championship. Ellis, who has refused to permit himself to be drafted into the U.S. Army.

Quarry won his way into the final of the elimination series when he beat Thad Spencer last Saturday. Ellis already had won the right to fight in the final.

THE DETROIT PISTONS have two new faces. They picked up Happy Hairston and Jim Fox from Cincinnati in exchange for John Tresvant and Tom Van Arsdale just before last Thursday's trading deadline.

The Pistons feel Hairston will add firepower and speed to their attack while the 6-10 Fox could surprise and prove a valued back-up man behind Joe

Strawder at center.

Pistons play at Chicago Thursday and Boston Friday before returning home Saturday night against Baltimore. The Boston Celtics appear at Cobo Arena next Tuesday night.
