'Guess Who' Will Please All Appetites

tion of "Guess Who's Coming To Dinner?" currently on view at Livonia's Mai Kai and De-

trout's Mercury Theaters is a sumptuous repeat certainly to all appetites.

First course served in beautiful Technicolor is a highly topical, adult script by William Rose. The confrontation scene between father and son contains verbal dynamite. The step accuses the father thinking of himself as a colored man while the son thinks of himself as a man equal in every way to all other men.

Four letter words and other realistic profane expression pepper the script and give it a zesty quality. The reference to Martin Luther King and black power are only two instances of its topical nature.

AFTER SAMPLING the succulent soup course, you are ready to settle down to a tossed salad of fresh, crisp acting by a trio of talented folks, Sidney Poitier, Spencer Tracy, and Katharine Hepburn vie for top honors.

It's a dead heat. Tracy in

his final picture might get top honors on a sentimental basis. However, it's still a superb three-way effort with Katharine Hepburn coming up strong on the outside.

"Guess Who's Coming To Dinner" was the last picture that Tracy did before his death. In fact, five times during the filming production it had to be stopped until he recovered.

Kathie Hepburn, one of his closest friends, had to have little motivation for her misty-eyed scenes. She somehow sensed that this was the last picture for the King of all character actors.

SPENCER DOES a magnificent bit of acting in his scene as he contemplates giving approval to the marriage of his daughter to a Negro.

His facial nuances, the slight mannerisms, and then finally his line, "Well, I'll be a son-of-a-bitch!" is memorable. From that sequence right into his final speech in which he re-
