

'Laurel And Hardy Festival' To Open

A special "Laurel and Hardy Festival" will kick off the spring program of the Henry Ford Museum's Famous Early Movie Series beginning Feb. 18.

In addition to some of the comedy team's classics, a personal friend of the late Stan Laurel, Dr. John McCabe, will present an illustrated talk tracing the careers of the pair.

McCabe is the author of the biography, "Mr. Laurel and Mr. Hardy." A native of the area, McCabe is currently the chairman of the Department of Drama and Theater Arts at Mackacac College.

His lecture will be presented at 2 and 4 p.m., Sunday, Feb. 18, in the Henry Ford Museum Theater. Slides and film clips of great moments in Laurel and Hardy films will illustrate the talk.

FIVE of the best Laurel and Hardy films will be presented Feb. 25 and March 3.

Included in the Feb. 25 program are: "The Finishing Touch" (1928), "Grate" (1930) and "The Laurel and Hardy Murder Case" (1930).

"Big Business" (1929) and "Blockheads" (1938) will complete the March 3 bill.

"The Story of Celeste" by Kleinsinger is about a lonesome little tune whose search for someone to belong to leads her into mistourture. Many characters come alive through the sounds of instruments and the story has a Cinderella ending when Celeste finally meets her Prince Cello.

Other works to be heard on the program are Mozart's "Abduction from the Seraglio," Bizet's "Carmen Suite No. 1," Ringler's "Dance Rhythms," and Borodin's "Polovetzian Dances from "Prince Igor."
