Dr. Eric J. Bradner, president of the college, and two members of the Board of Trustees will head a group of six representatives from Schoolcraft College at the 48th annual convention of the American Association of Junior Colleges Feb. 26 to March 1 at Boston.

Attending, other than Dr. Bradner, will be Mrs. Dave Moehle, Plymouth, vice-chairman of the Board, Trustee Dr. George Martin, Livonia; John H. Brimo, vice-president for instruction; Joe P. Adams, dean of technical-vocational instruction; and Robert A. Stenger, dean of academic instruction.

They will be among 1,500 administrators, faculty members and governing board members from two-year colleges throughout the country attending the meetings in the Sheraton-Boston Hotel.

The Association, which represents a majority of the country's two-year colleges, will consider issues and problems in higher education related to junior college development.

## U-M To Honor Chairman Of Litton Inc.

Charles B. "Tex" Thornton, chairman of Litton Industries, Inc., will receive the 1968 Business Leadership Award of The University of Michigan's Graduate School of Business Administration.

The award is made annually to a prominent businessman who has shown an understanding of the responsibility of business to society and an interest in business education. The recipient is chosen jointly by the students and faculty of the business school.

The award ceremony will be in Rackham Lecture Hall on the campus at 8 p.m. Friday, March 15. The gold medal and parchment scroll will be presented by Thomas McCrath and Roger Mizura, president and vice president of the business school's student council. After the presentation, Thornton will give the 11th annual Business Leadership Award address.

Thornton is a former leader of Ford Motor Co.'s "Whiz Kids"—whose members included Defense Secretary Robert McNamara and Ford President Arley Miller.

He is Robert McMath, 44, of 30886 Old Bedford, commander of the 121st Tactical Reconnaissance Wing, which meets monthly in Detroit, Battle Creek and Lincoln, Neb.

In private life, he has been an executive pilot for the Ford Motor Co.'s Air Transport Division for the past 14 years. The promotion was announced by Maj. Gen. C.C. Schlipke, adjutant general of Michigan.

IT IS THE High point of a 25-year career. A native of Scotland, McMath grew up in Detroit and attended Henry Ford Trade School to become an apprentice body design engineer.

Late in 1942, he enlisted as an aviation cadet in the Army Air Force, was commissioned a second lieutenant after completing flight training, and flew 35 combat missions over Europe as a B-17 pilot.

He became commander of the 121st Tactical Reconnaissance Wing in April of 1966. With 2,900 guardsmen, his units fly the RF 84F and RB 57 aircraft in photo reconnaissance work.
